The provision of this type of scholarships upholds one of the primary goals of IVEC, which is to offer comprehensive development opportunities for students and professionals interested in Virtual Exchange.

Any individual is welcome to apply, although we especially welcome applications that will help us increase the diversity of attendees. Given the hybrid format of the conference, you can apply for a scholarship if you are interested in attending the conference in person or virtually.

Please do not register for the conference until you have been notified regarding the status of your scholarship application.

APPLICATION, REQUIREMENTS, AND CRITERIA IVEC 2022 SCHOLARSHIPS

Dates and Deadlines

IVEC 2022 Steering committee offers scholarships covering the cost for registration and accommodation for **ON SITE** or **ONLINE** attendance

There will be up to two application phases for the scholarships, as described below:

- Phase 1 – **January 1st 2022 to June 30th 2022 (00h00 CET)**

Communication of scholarship award to applicants: July 1st 2022 to July 15th 2022

Should there remain a surplus of scholarships following the first application phase, via the website we will advertise the activation of a second phase as described below:

- Phase 2 - **July 15th 2022 to August 31st 2022**

Communication of scholarship award to applicants: September 1st 2022 to September 15th 2022

Requirements and Eligibility

All applicants must meet the following requirements and eligibility in order for the application to be forwarded to the committee for consideration:

- You must complete the application form fully, supplying the requested information
- All applicants must fill out an individual form (group requests are not accepted)
- The applicant may receive reasonable requests for verification or to ask for additional information or clarification, which should be fulfilled at the earliest possible opportunity

Evaluation Criteria

The applicants request for a scholarship will be articulated via an online form in which we will gather information purely for the purposes of determining suitability for awarding of the scholarship.

No other use will be made of the information submitted through this process.

The form consists of a series of closed and open-ended questions. The closed-ended questions will be used to score the candidates whilst the open-ended questions will be employed as tie breakers in the case of equal points.

The scoring system will evaluate the following components of your application:

- Your institution of origin
- Your role at your institution
- The region in which your institution is based
- Your past attendances at IVEC conferences
- Consideration of whether or not you have made an application to present a talk or poster at this year's conference and the status of that application
